Staying on Campus

Simple and comfortable lodging is provided in NMSD's Cottages. Rooms have two beds, two closets and a private bath. Extra mattresses can be added to rooms for larger families. Simple bedding and towels are provided. A kitchen and refrigerator are in each cottage for community use. Cottages are air conditioned, but temperatures are not controllable. Some people bring fans.

Children's Programming



Children's programming is provided for all children from 18 mo. to 12 yrs. old. This program has deaf and hearing staff. Infants and children over age 12 are welcome to attend adult classes with adults from their family.
